Rules & Regulations for Participants

1. Eligibility & Registration

1. Participation is **open to students from outside schools** within the prescribed **Class/Age Groups**:
 - **Group A:** Classes 1 to 3
 - **Group B:** Class 4 to 6
 - **Group c:** Classes 7 to 8
2. **Online registration is mandatory.** No on spot registrations will be entertained under any circumstances.
3. Each participant is permitted to **participate in only two category**:
 - **PANKH – Sur (Singing)**
 - **PANKH – Nritya (Dance)**
 - **PANKH – Kala (Art & Craft)**
 - **PANKH – Vaani Vikas (Public Speaking)**
 - **PANKH – Kavya Udaan**
 - **PANKH- Masterchef**
 - **PANKH – RoboSpark**
 - **PANKH – Waste to Wow! (Sustainability, Eco Friendly Solutions)**
 - **PANKH – Talking Puppets**
 - **PANKH – Hackathon (Coding)**
 - **PANKH- Aacharan**
4. Registration details must be **accurate and verifiable.** Any mismatch may lead to disqualification.

2. Identity Verification & Campus Entry

1. Participants must carry a **valid School ID Card** (of current session) for verification.
2. Entry into the campus will be granted **only after identity verification** at the registration desk.
3. A maximum of **two (2) parents/guardians/siblings** are permitted to accompany each participant.
4. Entry passes issued at registration must be **displayed at all times** within the campus.

3. General Conduct & Discipline

1. Participants and accompanying guardians must **adhere to campus discipline, decorum, and instructions** issued by organisers.
2. Any form of **misconduct, indiscipline, or non-cooperation** may result in immediate disqualification and campus exit immediately.
3. Participants must report to their respective venues **well before the scheduled time**. Late reporting may lead to forfeiture.

PANKH- Aacharan		Counselling sessions will address age-appropriate developmental changes, social media and screen addiction, parenting styles, emotional regulation, peer pressure, self-esteem, academic stress, communication gaps, and building healthy habits.
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PANKH – CATEGORY-WISE COMPETITION RULES

A. PANKH – Sur (Singing)

- Solo performance only.
- Time limit: 2–3 minutes.
- Karaoke tracks (if required) must be brought by the participant in advance (pen drive/mobile).
- Songs must be age-appropriate in lyrics, theme, and presentation.
- Use of explicit language, offensive lyrics, or inappropriate gestures is strictly prohibited.
- Judgement will be based on voice quality, rhythm, confidence, and overall presentation.
- Judges' decisions shall be final and binding.

B. PANKH – Nritya / Manch (Dance)

- Solo performance unless otherwise specified.
- Time limit: 2–3 minutes.
- Music tracks must be arranged by the participant.
- Props are allowed but must be safe, light, and non-hazardous.
- Any prop causing damage to stage/property will lead to penalty or disqualification.
- Costume, theme, and choreography must be culturally sensitive and age-appropriate.
- Obscene or inappropriate movements are strictly prohibited.

C. PANKH – Kala (Art & Craft / Sculpture / Clay Modelling)

- All artwork must be original and created on the spot.
- Only manual work is permitted; no traced, pre-printed, or digital artwork is allowed.
- Participants must bring their own waste materials as per the theme.
- No assistance from parents, guardians, or teachers is permitted.
- Time limit: 45 minutes.
- Judgement will be based on creativity, imagination, neatness, theme relevance, and effort.

D. PANKH – Vaani Vikas (Public Speaking & Poetry Recitation)

Public Speaking

- Topic/theme must be chosen only from the given list.
- Time limit:
 - Classes 1–3: 1–2 minutes
 - Classes 4–8: 2–3 minutes
- Reading from paper, cue cards, or mobile phones is not allowed.
- Content must be original, respectful, and age-appropriate.
- Judgement criteria: clarity, confidence, expression, body language, and time management.

Poetry Recitation – PANKH: Kavya Udaan

- Poems must belong to the approved genres (value-based, patriotic, motivational, reflective, nature-based).
- Emphasis on voice modulation, rhythm, and emotional expression.

- No background music, props, or dramatic costumes allowed.

E. PANKH – RoboSpark (Robotics)

- **Orientation & briefing:** 10–15 minutes
 - **Problem-solving & development:** 45 minutes
- Total duration:** Approximately 1 hour

Classes 4–6 | RoboMove Mission

- Brief training and demonstration will be provided.
- Students must complete a basic movement-based robotics task.
- Total duration: up to 1 hour.
- Judgement based on task completion, accuracy, and teamwork.

Classes 7–8 | RoboTask Challenge

- Problem statements will be given on the spot.
- Students must complete the task within one hour.
- Judgement based on logic, execution, innovation, and explanation.
- Mishandling of equipment or unsafe conduct will result in disqualification.

(All robotics equipment will be provided by the school.)

F. PANKH – Waste to Wow! (Best Out of Waste)

- Participants must bring their own waste materials as per the theme.
- Items must be created strictly during the allotted time.
- Use of sharp, hazardous, or unsafe objects is strictly prohibited.
- Time limit: 45 minutes.
- Judgement based on creativity, usefulness, eco-sensitivity, and finish.

G. PANKH – The Talking Puppets (Puppet Storytelling)

- The story must align with the assigned theme.
- Participants must bring their own materials for making their puppet.
- Puppet making: 40 minutes
- Story narration: 3–4 minutes
- Language must be clear, respectful, and age-appropriate.
- Judgement based on storytelling skills, voice modulation, creativity, and coordination.

H. PANKH – Hackathon (coding Challenge)

- **Orientation & briefing:** 10–15 minutes
 - **Problem-solving & development:** 45 minutes
- Total duration:** Approximately 1 hour

Rules & Guidelines

- Participants must work independently.
- Use of pre-written code, saved programs, or external help is strictly prohibited.
- The solution must be original and created during the competition time.
- Participants must be able to explain their logic and approach clearly.
- Any unsafe handling of devices or misconduct will lead to disqualification.

I. PANKH – Masterchef

- Individual participation only.
- Participation is open as per the assigned age group.
- Time Limit: 60 minutes will be allotted for preparation and presentation.
- Materials & Ingredients: All ingredients, utensils, plates, spoons, napkins, and decorative items must be brought by the participant.

- Only fire-free, no-cook ingredients are allowed (fruits, vegetables, bread, sprouts, dry fruits, etc.).
- Use of gas, stove, induction, microwave, heater, or any electrical appliance is strictly prohibited.
- Hygiene & Safety: Participants must maintain proper hygiene (clean hands, covered food).
- Food must be safe, fresh, and suitable for consumption. The dish should be simple, nutritious, and age-appropriate.
- Artificial colours, unsafe decorations, or wasteful presentation should be avoided.

GENERAL RULES (Applicable to All Competitions)

- Participants must report to the venue well before the scheduled time.
- Late reporting may result in forfeiture of turn.
- Any form of indiscipline, misconduct, or rule violation will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Judges' decisions are final and binding.
- The school reserves the right to modify rules in the interest of safety and smooth conduct of the event.
